


PUBLIX SUPER MARKETS AND SPECIAL OLYMPICS FLORIDA

Special Olympics is the world's largest program of sports training, athletic competition, and critical health services to children and adults with intellectual disabilities. It currently serves more than 5 million persons with intellectual disabilities in more than 165nations. Here in Florida, we currently have over 60,000 athletes who are training and competing year round in sports of their choice.
